March to July.

FLORA OF JERSEY.

Since Engler and Prantl merged the Linnæan genus TILLÆA into CRASSULA in 1890, no new list of CRASSULA has been published. The specific name MUSCOSA is not available, as there is already an African CRASSULA MUSCOSA L. I am therefore obliged reluctantly to suggest a new specific name. Bentham and Hooker describe TILLÆA as "genus vix a Crassula distinguendum."
